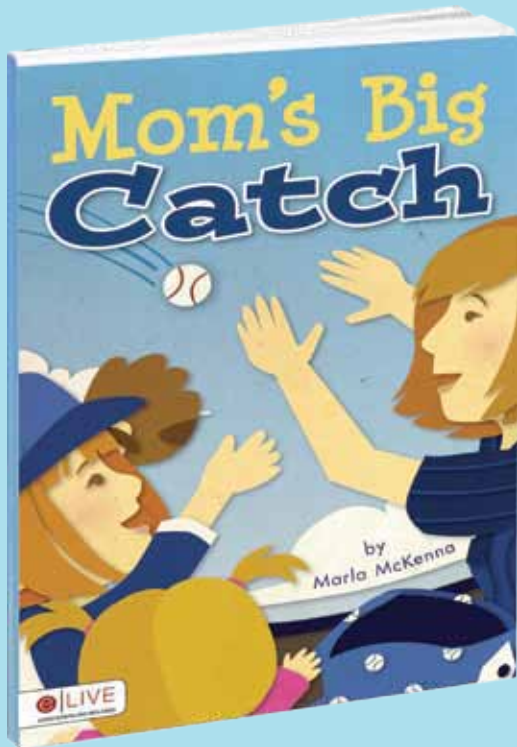


Family Literacy Nights
